

Annual Report Public Notice  
2008 – 2009 Permit Year

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation requires that specified municipalities that own or operate separate storm sewer systems implement a program to reduce the discharge of pollutants in order to protect water quality. Monroe County, the City of Rochester, SUNY Brockport, and the Towns of Brighton, Chili, Clarkson, Gates, Greece, Henrietta, Irondequoit, Mendon, Ogden, Parma, Penfield, Perinton, Pittsford, Sweden, and Webster, as well as the Villages of Brockport, East Rochester, Fairport, Hilton, Pittsford, Spencerport, and Webster have developed a shared annual report that documents their program.
