Discover Buffalo – The History – Sights - Food
Buffalo, NY

The Buffalo Naval Park takes you inside our nation's military history, as well as fascinating exhibits and displays including historic documents, uniforms, military gear, photographs and much more. Get ready to tour incredible vessels such as Missile Cruiser, a Destroyer and a WWII submarine. For lunch we will experience the Anchor Bar – famed birthplace of the Buffalo chicken wing and by popular demand we will visit the Pierce Arrow Museum. This is a self-guided tour exploring the history of transportation from bicycles to cars and view the design of world renowned architect Frank Lloyd Wright's unique fuel filling station that was never even built. Time to Play & Explore Eden/Dunkirk
Eden-Dunkirk, NY

Our day starts in Eden at the original American Kazoo Company that was established in 1916; the first metal kazoo factory and the only one in North America. The museum highlights history, amusing trivia, and shows step by step the way kazoos are made and today you can make one to take home! Lunch will be at Demetri's overlooking the shores of Lake Erie. We then take a short drive along the shore to tour the Dunkirk Light House and Museum to explore the historic operational lighthouse and admire the magnificent views from the observation deck - bring your camera. We then head for home and stop in East Aurora for some shopping or browsing of Vidler's 5 & 10.

GLOW Tour-Genesee, Livingston, Orleans & Wyoming Counties

This will be a fun day of experiences with our feet in four counties. We head west to Medina, where you will pick out a figurine for your choice at Hands on Paint and create a masterpiece of art you can call your own. Hungry.... we will enjoy lunch at the "Hole in the Wall" - a popular place in Perry. We then travel to the Hemlock Hill Alpaca Farm, where you will learn the history of the Alpaca. Did you know that Alpacas were domesticated some 6,000 years ago by the native people of the Andean Altiplano and cherished for their luxurious fiber? Keep your adventure going with our last stop of the day at the Interpretive Nature Center in East Bethany where you will enjoy the exhibits and history of the local land and parks.

Registration Procedure and Information:

1. Pick-up and departure from Hilton Senior Center, 59 Henry Street, Hilton, NY.
2. ***Since the Town of Parma subsidizes these trips, they are open to Town of Parma*** residents age 55 and up at a subsidized rate. Those who do not live in the Town of Parma will be accommodated if space is available; however they will be required to register at a non-resident rate.
 - a. **If you pay Hilton School Taxes but do not pay Town of Parma taxes, the non-resident rate will apply.**
3. The following is the procedure for trip registration: Complete registration form or register online at www.parmany.org/Recreation at any time after a trip is advertised. Completed forms should be turned into the Recreation Office. For any seating requests, submit information on the registration form with any other requirements such as food choice and emergency contact. Places cannot be held for people without payment and we will take a waiting list if a bus fills. If cancellations occur, placements will be taken in order from the waiting list.
4. We recommend that interested participants register for any trip by the stated registration deadline or 3-4 weeks prior to the trip date at the latest to insure that the trip does occur.
5. **REMINDER:** The first two sets of seats are reserved for those who have a difficult time maneuvering up and down the aisle and will be rotated to share this opportunity to all. **NOTE:** Front seat requests will be taken at registration, but please be aware that these seats are limited.
6. Please be at the pick-up point at least 10 minutes prior to the designated departure time. **Passengers should NOT plan to board the bus early to save seats.**
7. We are required to have a minimum number of people attend each trip. If our minimum is not reached, other options will be explored, including a possible cancellation of the trip.
8. For your safety, we ask that you remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop.
9. Payment by check, cash, money order, MasterCard, Discover or Visa is accepted. Make checks payable to: **Town of Parma.**
10. Other day trips not included on this document may be added throughout the year.

Cancellations & Refund Policy:

1. Cancellations received in the Recreation Department (392-9030) prior to the trip registration deadline may be refunded with a processing fee of 10%. Cancellations received after the deadline or "no shows" will **NOT** receive a refund unless someone else is found to take the place of the cancelled party. **We will attempt to give refunds whenever possible, but please realize that refunds are NOT guaranteed.** If a refund is approved you also have the option to put a full credit for the amount paid on your account to be used at a later date.
2. All replacements will be handled by the Recreation Department from the waiting list if one exists. You may give your spot to a friend if there is no waiting list established.
